

Press Notes:

'Partners' is a proof of concept for our feature screenplay 'The Big Yarn'.

Filmed on location in Karratha; a mining town 1500 kms (1000 miles) from the nearest city.

Our main location was a real-life explosives depot. A controlled explosion had to be called off and written out of the film, after wind conditions changed on the day of filming.

Despite filming in April- which typically has zero days of rain- we experienced a torrential downpour from a nearby tropical cyclone on our first day of filming.

Our creative team conducted workshops with aspiring local film makers prior to the shoot.

The supporting actors are all Karratha locals.

Producer Cath Trimboli had to run the shoot from her home in Perth, after she was denied medical permission to fly to Karratha due to pregnancy complications. During post production, baby Johnny was born: happy, healthy, and a HUGE 'Partners' fan!

The original score is inspired by Spaghetti Western legend Ennio Morricone.



As a director and performer, Henry has been responsible for some of Australia's most successful web series, short films, and advertisements, with more than 20 million hits on YouTube. Most recently, Henry has written and directed 'The Legend of Gavin Tanner'; a comedy pilot for ABC TV, as well as the Melbourne Webfest and WASA Award winning animation 'The Shapes'.




Formerly a television reporter and documentary film maker, Jules has been identified by Screen Australia's 'Talent Escalator' programme as a screenwriter to watch.
